

Killara Feedlot Pollution Incident Response Management Plan (PIRMP)

1. Background

Under Part 5.7A of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (POEO Act) all holders of environment protection licences (licensees) are required to prepare, keep, test and implement a Pollution Incident Response Management Plan (PIRMP). Parts of the PIRMP must be made publicly available by placing the PIRMP on the website of the licensee and is to include,

- Procedures for contacting the relevant authorities including EPA, Local Council, NSW Health, SafeWork NSW, Fire & Rescue NSW and their contact details.
- Procedure for contacting the owner or occupier of premises in the vicinity.
- Procedure for communicating with the community
- Mechanisms for providing early warnings and regular updates to premises in the vicinity

2. Procedure for Contacting Relevant Authorities

- The General Manager is responsible for all communications in the event of a pollution incident; in the absence of the general manager the Feedlot Manager is responsible or in the absence of both the Commercial & Financial Manager is responsible.
- Communication is to be made by telephone

3. Procedure for Contacting Owners or Occupiers of Premises in the vicinity

- Killara Feedlot is in a rural setting with no occupiers of premises adjacent to the property
- Killara has two immediate neighbours within a 1km radius, in the event of a pollution incident the neighbours would be contacted by telephone & text message.

4. Procedure for Communicating with the Community

Communication with the local community would include:

- Telephone and/or Text Message
- Email
- Local 2-way radio to known neighbouring channels and/or door knocking

5. Mechanisms for providing early warnings & regular updates to premises in the vicinity

The same procedure will apply as communicating with the community
